- Conduct a follow-up meeting 1-2 months after the summit;
- Select the date for the 2009 Summit at the September 26 meeting in Albany; send out "Save the Date" cards in the fall;

The remainder of the meeting was dedicated to planning the Summer Symposium. Central Islip would like to send 20 teachers and Freeport will send 5. Patchogue-Medford has contacted Darra. Since the original plan and funding was for 25 participants, Dolores will contact Matt Giugno to ask about how to proceed. We anticipate that the State will provide for a larger Symposium.
